



Waterfront Master Plan

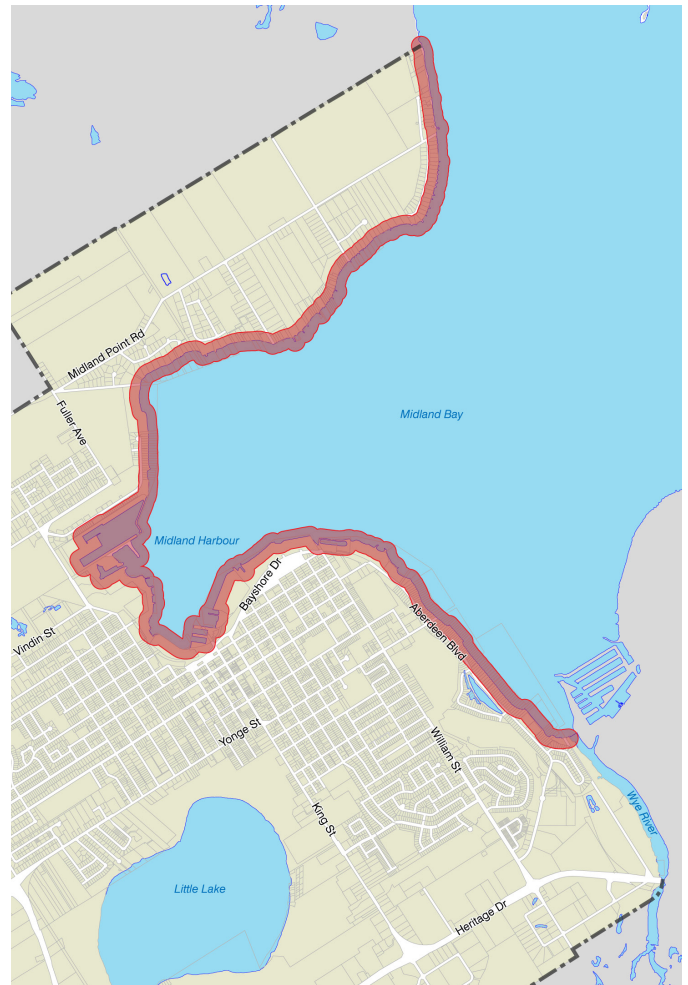
The Town of Midland has initiated a Waterfront Master Plan to create a vision that will meet the needs of the Town's residents. The Master Plan will build on the recommendations of previous studies, including the Downtown Master Plan, and explore opportunities to enhance public access, protect natural and cultural heritage, provide more opportunities for recreation, and accommodate well designed new residential and commercial uses.

The Master Plan will be developed over the next few months beginning with a review and analysis of previous recommendations and confirmation of key opportunities for change, followed by the preparation of a vision, land use policy framework and strategic initiatives, followed by the identification of phasing, costs and actions required for implementation.
